Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, “What do you want?” They said, “Rabbi: (which means Teacher), “where are you staying?” “Come,” he said, “and you will see.” John 1:38-39 (NIV)

- **Bears Much Fruit**
- **Loves One Another**
- **Makes Other Followers**
